SRW Paver Seal features this easy 4-step process to save time and money. SRW prides itself on offering user-friendly (yet detailed) instructions to assist in the success of your paver projects.



- polymeric sand before sealing. Thoroughly sweep surface of
- joint sand or loose material. Spot clean if needed with one of these SRW cleaning products: **CD** = Cleaner & Degreaser for oil and grease spots **RE** = Rust Eliminator for rust and mineral removal
- Prepare all pavers with one of these SRW cleaning products: **EF** = for Efflorescence removal **PW** = Paver Wash for general cleaning & polyhaze removal

- After cleaning, wait at least 24 hours before sealing. Surface and joints must be completely dry.
- Recommended application temperatures are 50°F (10°C) to 80°F (27°C).
- Do not apply if inclement weather is forecasted within 24 hours.

- STIR THOROUGHLY. Apply with an SRW Products approved Slit Foam Roller
- and sprayer. Spray then back roll. This prevents an uneven finish. A 2-person application is
- recommended. Always spray against a wet edge and do not overlap a previously sealed and dried area.

- Start at the highest project elevation.
- Do not allow sealer to pool on pavers or in joints.
- · Repeat if desired. (Except PS & PSX)

FAQ



How long should I wait after installing polymeric sand?



Wait for sand to fully cure before sealing. Be sure the moisture has been released. We recommend waiting at least 28 days.

What do I use to clean up?



SRW XY Xylene is a fast-acting solvent that thins and dissolves acrylic sealer to aid in tool clean up and overspray.

What if I need to remove sealer?



SRW has a solution for every need. SS Sealer Stripper is a biodegradable, yet industrial-strength formula that removes sealing and curing compounds.

Can I seal if rain is in the forecast?



SRW recommends a clear forecast for at least 24 hours before and after sealer application.

Is it necessary to use an SRW Slit Foam Roller?



Yes. A slit foam roller is the best choice for backrolling because it helps evenly distribute the sealer and prevent it from pooling.

Is it necessary to use a sprayer to apply?



While you can successfully apply SRW sealers using only a Slit Foam Roller, it is highly recommended that a sprayer is used to apply an even coat. A second

person would then follow the sprayer with a slit foam roller to make sure the sealer is evenly distributed and prevent it from pooling.
